## Whites:

Chignin Bergeron 2009, Domaine Adrien Berlioz, Savoie	20€
All right. Savoie wines don't have a great reputation. Now, if we dare to put it on our wine lists in because this winemaker does a great job! This wine is made from Roussane grape variety (think Crozes Hermitage Blanc). A great wine for pre dinner drink	
Roussette Zulime 2009, Domaine Adrien Berlioz, Savoie	23€
A second wine from Adrien Berlioz. By the way, the entire Domaine is now organic (from vintages 2010). Roussette is an old grape variety from Savoie. It's rich, opulent, yet extremely well balanced with some exotic fruit flavours.	
Sancerre Blanc 2009, Domaine Gérard Fiou, Loire	25€
Everybody knows Sancerre! They produce some of the best Sauvignon Blanc in the world. Fruity, flinty and aromatic, this one in a great example. It comes from Saint Satur, one of the best slope in Sancerre. The vinification is done by Domaine Henri Bourgeois, one of the iconic domaine of this appelation.	
Marsannay 2008, Domaine Charles Audoin, Bourgogne	30€
You like the crispiness of a Chablis and the opulence of a Meursault? Well, this wine has a bit of both!	
Savigny-lès-Beaune «Goudelettes» 2009, Domaine Seguin-Manuel, Bourgogne	40€
Please note the name of this winemaker. Thibaut Marion took over this domaine in Beaune in 2004. His Goudelettes has won many awards since then including a gold medal and a trophy at the international wine challenge! A Classy and classic top end chardonnay from the iconic côte de Beaune.

Les Grès de Montpellier 2008, Domaine de Roquemale, Languedoc	18€
Fine wine from Languedoc. A great Syrah/Grenache blend from an organic Domaine located North of Montpellier	
Sancerre Rouge 2008, Domaine Gérard Fiou, Loire	27 €
Why Sancerre have to be white? This cuvée from very old vines of Pinot Noir has great aromas of ripe red fruits and shows a very feminine character.	
Pavillon de Taillefer 2008, Chateau Vieux Taillefer, Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux	35€
SHE make it. She? Catherine Cohen who took over this chateau after a remarquable career as wine consultant in the Bordeaux region. This gourmet wine is fruity with a great structure. A must try wine!	
Chateau Vieux Taillefer 2007, Saint Emilion Grand Cru, Bordeaux	55€
The big daddy of the domaine. Decant it and let its aromas and complexity charm you. Brilliant Intensity and depth of flavours.	
Gevrey-Chambertin 1er Cru «aux combottes» 2008, Domaine Odoul-Coquard, Morey-Saint-Denis Burgundy	80 €
We have a soft spot for Red Burgundy from the côte de Nuits. Pinot Noir is shown here at its best and Odoul-Coquard does it extremely well: Low impact farming and precise vinification produces this classy and stylish Gevrey.	
Clos de Vougeot Grand Cru 2008, Domaine Odoul-Coquard, Morey-Saint-Denis, Burgundy	95€
A Grand cru from the nearby vineyard of the wine above. with crunchy raspberry fruit, well integrated spicy oak, fresh acidity and fine-grained, ripe tannins this is a top end Pinot Noir!
